Frequently Asked Questions

This guide was prepared to prepare you for what to expect in our next phase of public worship.

When will worship take place?

Beginning April 4, we will offer worship services at 8:30 & 10:30 am. The 8:30 am service will be mask required in the building for the entire service. The 10:30 service does not require social distancing and is mask optional in the church building however the Lecture Hall will remain 'mask required'. You can use the North office entrance by the visitor parking for entry to the Lecture Hall.

Who should attend?

If you are sick stay home. While those at risk and those who are in close contact with those at risk are in process of getting vaccinated, we are offering the 8:30 am mask only service. We will continue to provide worship on Facebook live at 10:30 am, which will also be available to watch at later times on our Facebook page.

Do I need to make a reservation?

You do not need to make a reservation.

Will masks be required?

8:30 am service:

To protect others, all those attending age 10 and older will be required to wear a mask while in the building including the worship service. Please bring a mask with you to worship. We will have a small supply of masks available at the door.

10:30 am service:

Beginning April 4, the 10:30 service does not require social distancing and is mask optional in the church building however the Lecture Hall will remain 'mask required'. You can use the North office entrance by the visitor parking for entry to the Lecture Hall.

Where will I enter the church building?

There will be three entrances used. The Fellowship Hall door and the main entrance under the covered drive-through and the North office door closest to the visitor parking. Greeters will be there to welcome you and direct you. There will be hand sanitation stations and the Greeters will have masks available.

How will social distancing measures be managed?

8:30 am: The Fellowship Hall sliding doors will be open along with two of the main sanctuary doors. The floor will be marked for social distancing. Every other row will remain empty and, spacing between seating will maintain social distancing. We ask that you continue social distancing practices while on the property during the 8:30 am service.

10:30 am: There is no social distancing requirement for the 10:30 am service.

How will worship be structured?

We will have communion with each service. 8:30 am the elements will be distributed after servers have sanitized their hands and put fresh gloves on. 10:30 am servers will remain up front as the congregation is released to come forward for the elements. We will have offering stations at the entrance/exits in the sanctuary, or you can give online. Bulletins will be available or you can use the digital version on our website under Media, Worship Bulletins.

Will Nursery or KIWI be available?

Nursery Infant – 3-year-old began September 6. Check in is in the Nursery Hallway. Until KIWI resumes we want your children to feel comfortable in worship. We will have crafts and/or worksheets available for your children each week. The Cry Room is available and allows you to still see and hear worship service. We are working on being able to offer KIWI again in the coming months.

What is the plan for cleaning between services?

We will have trained volunteers disinfecting between services in the areas that we will be using.

What changes have you made to the HVAC?

We have installed [REME Halo in-duct air purifiers](#) in the sanctuary to improve the air quality and reduce risk.
